From The Principal's Desk

Message

“Although the world is full of suffering, it is also full of the overcoming of it.”

Helen Keller’s words ring true as nations the world over grappled with the devastating wave of death and suffering that COVID 19 brought along. The loss was immeasurable, loss of loved ones for some and loss of livelihood for several others. Closer home, we lost two of our finest colleagues, Dr. Trayambak Nath Tripathi, Assistant Professor, Department of Hindi and Mr. Sushil Kumar Kaushil, Technical Assistant. A loss which is immeasurable as two strong pillars of the Maharaja Agrasen community lost their lives in this raging pandemic. They will be deeply missed and very fondly remembered. Besides these two cherished souls, several colleagues and students lost their loved ones and most battled covid and still suffer from its after effects, but in the midst of all of this, all stakeholders stood together as one big family, reaching out to each other to give medical, financial and emotional support. It is this spirit which holds the community together, which is the backbone of every nation, and which makes us stronger and closer. Maharaja Agrasen College is committed to serve the society and stands with the nation in this hour of need. It successfully ran a Quarantine Centre with the support of Government of NCT of Delhi from May to September 2020 in which around 1000 persons from 8 different countries stayed for 7 days each and availed home like facilities away from their home.

The pandemic brought along several challenges but with each challenge, there was an opportunity to learn and evolve. The teaching-learning process witnessed several changes as teaching was held entirely online, and end term exams were held as open book examinations in the virtual space. Faculty rose to the occasion and worked tirelessly to ensure that students did not suffer, and syllabus was covered on time. Besides academics, continuation of extra curricular and other activities was ensured by committees and departments which reaffirm our commitment to students’ holistic development. The long-standing demand of girl students to start an NCC 2GDDN unit at Maharaja Agrasen College was realized through inducting 54 girlcadets in the first batch out of total allocated strength of 160.

The entire academic year of 2020-21 was vibrant with webinars and workshops, special lectures, and competitions. A large number of faculty members participated in faculty development programs, presented papers in seminars and conferences, contributed research papers in journals and wrote and edited several books. The administrative staff came to college despite the risk of contracting the virus and ensured that all administrative matters were attended to. Though social distancing and appropriate protocols were maintained and followed, yet they rose above their fears to fulfill their duties. This report evinces the fruits of the struggle, the result of the proactive engagements of faculty, administrative staff, and students and none of this would have been possible without the support of the Governing Body for which we are all grateful.

I would also like to place on record that in the history of this institution, more than 30 faculties were promoted, and

20 promotions are under process to the next scale. Furthermore, 12 new postgraduate and undergraduate courses were finalized for approval by the competent authority. Our improved all India rankings in NIRF and MDRA India Today are also testimony that we are moving in the right direction. We have come a long way but there is still much more to be achieved, several milestones to be crossed and I am positive that the collective spirit and endeavour shall take us to greater heights.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS

B.A. PROGRAMME

If we are to draw a simile for B.A. Programme it would go something like this; B. A. Programme is like India: Diverse yet unified. This attribution can also be said as B. A. Programme being a flexible, inter-disciplinary and choice-based programme that suits the needs and interest of the academicians and athletics alike. It aims to prepare them with intellect and skills necessary to lead a meaningful life. Along with focusing on academics, the college also aims to provide for holistic development of the students via the medium of the B. A. Programme Society, properly known as Lakshya. About 300 students are enrolled in the B. A. Programme Department at the Maharaja Agrasen College, University of Delhi. Hence, there is plenty of potential for co-curricular activities as well as a need for socializing outside classes. Keeping this in mind, the Lakshya Society organized various activities in the academic year of 2020-2021 to allow students to express themselves, learn and evolve at the same time.

As said by Ola Joseph, "Diversity is about embracing one another's uniqueness." Abhikalpan, the Intra-college Co-Curricular Fest organized by Lakshya Society from 16 April to 25 April 2021, embraced each subject and every student and gave them a chance to showcase their talents. The six-day fest had a range of competitions including math-a-thon, quiz, debate, acting, marketing, etc. with association with subjects. The fest successfully ended with mass participation from the college, great events and a prize-giving and valedictory ceremony on 25 April, 2021. This fest gave a platform to the students to open up and innovate.

Our next event was organised on 5 June 2021, on the occasion of World Environment Day. With the eminence speakers, like Dr. Rajiv Bhartari, Dr. C. R. Babu, Ms. Gupta and Mrs. B. A. Umadevi were invited to help the students understand the importance of the environment and how they can help save it. The insightful speeches were followed by a walk in the Yamuna Biodiversity Park by Dr. Faiyaz A. Khudsar and Ms. Preeti Vohara. After the enlightening discussion and speeches students from our college expressed their concern and respect for the Mother Earth and the environment via the medium of their talented performances. Before the event, two pre-event competitions were also organized, based on Photography and Artistic Skills. Mass registrations were received, and winners were announced on the day of the event. This event gave the students a chance to learn more about the environment and understand the depth of the problem that it is facing.

The events were organised virtually under the experienced guidance of our convenor, Dr. Niraj Kumar Singh; and gave the first year students to take initiative and enhance their skills as organisers. 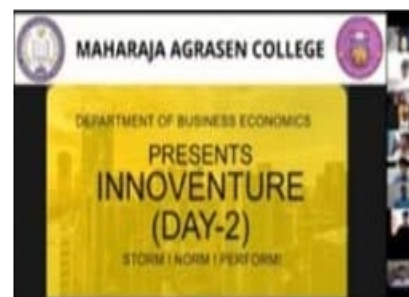
DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS ECONOMICS

The Department of Business Economics, through the events organized throughout the year, aims to inculcate the spirit of managerial decision making, optimum resource management, and developing business capabilities amongst its students. On 20 & 21 January 2021, a two-day online event 'Industrial Colloquium' was organized for the students of the Department. The aim was to bring out the investor's perspective within the students. An Alumni - cum - Corporate Interaction meet was held on 30 January 2021 on the topic 'Ahead, towards Corporate Arena'. A seminar on 'Startups: Ideation, Funding and growth' was held on 11 February 2021 which was an incredibly informative and enlightening webinar by Paresh Gupta (CA), a graduate of the London School of Business, an entrepreneur, a Startup mentor and a six times TEDx speaker.

Entreuzest, the annual flagship festival of the Department of Business Economics, was organized on 14-16 April 2021. This year the festival comprised of the following events: 1. Vaarta, 2. DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE

The MAC Commerce Society (MCS) worked throughout the year and organised the following events for students. A workshop detailing the know-how of creating a website from scratch using wordpress was organised on 16 October 2020 with Ms Bhawna Bhadwaj as the instructor. An Online Blogging Competition was organised on 1 November 2020 in which students had to create a website from scratch and publish their blogs on it, this was judged by the instructor. An online workshop on Artificial Intelligence was held on 1 November 2020 on Zoom and participants across 17 states with Dr Vishal Bhatnagar as the expert. Furthermore, an inter college quiz was organised on the themes of trivia and current affairs on 10 November 2020. Certificates of Participation and of merit were provided at the end of this bicameral event.

A workshop on Resume Writing was conducted by Dr Shweta Dixit, Sharda University on 13 January 2021, which aimed at busting various myths around resumes and covered various ideas for creating the most articulate and comprehensive resume. Fresher's 2020 was hosted online in lieu of the official departmental Freshers on 17 January 2021. It provided an opportunity to welcome and have a meet-and-greet session with first year students and to give away the titles of Mister and Miss Fresher. An online orientation session was held in the month of January for the upcoming batch of 2020-23 with the view of introducing them to the college and its activities. The event gave the freshers an overview of what they could expect in their college life.

Commcage - Case Study: A Chronicle-based problem solving Competition was held on 31st January 2021 to conquer which participants had to identify workable solutions to real life business problems. A total of Rs 2300/- was awarded as prize money to the top 3 working solutions. CRUSADE 2021 was organised online on 24 & 25 February 2021. The fest was hugely popular as the number of registrations for this year's edition crossed the 500 mark and a total of Rs 17,300 were awarded as prize money to the top 3 winners of all six events.

COMMERCE COMMUNITY SERVICE CELL



The community service cell started functioning in January 2021 and organized three intellectual events for the students for sharing their knowledge in a various skills like video editing, content writing, blog writing, and many more. All the events were organized online and students themselves acted as the resource persons. The moto of the cell is 'dissemination of knowledge amongst yourselves'. The first event was Canva and video editing online session which took place between 8 -10 February 2021 followed by an event on content writing on 1-2 March 2021. And finally, an intellectual webinar was organized about SAP software training and programming language (python, Java, web Designing, digital marketing) on 10 March 2021.

COMMERCE TRAINING PLACEMENT CELL

Commerce Department took the initiative of the Training & Placement Cell for the students of BCom Honours. The cell was brought into existence in December 2020 and started functioning in January 2021. Intra Cell Activities: 6 sessions were held by Komal Saxena (Technical Team) on Graphic Designing using Adobe Photoshop and 4 sessions were taken by Hitesh Kumar (Corporate Relations & Content writing Team) on the art of effective communication and LinkedIn Etiquettes. Student Relations and Social Media handles were run by Pranav Gupta and his team throughout the semester to enable easy access for the students of the college, leading to good interactions between the cell and the students. Shivalika Verma and Tanya Jolly are coordinators and held various meetings to discuss on going activities and prospects of the cell while preparing the team for potential challenges in lieu of the Pandemic going on, for the coming academic year. The Placement Cell has followed its motto 'Our Success lies in your success' in the most upright and ethical manner and hopes to continue in coming years too. More placement opportunities will be targeted for the coming academic years to ensure maximum employment through the campus.

Money Mail – The Finance Literacy cell (Commerce Department)

In the month of December, the Department of Commerce established a Finance Literacy cell for its students in academic session 2020-21. The goal was to impart financial knowledge to students who were part of this, so that they can have better career prospects when they graduate from the college. The cell started with 4 core members and 50 Members with students from all 3 years who organised various sessions and workshops.

DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMICS

The Department of Economics has always been actively involved in academic exercises. Teachers of the department have been participating and presenting papers in various Conferences, Seminars and Webinars at the National and

International levels, and have published papers in Refereed Journals and Chapters in Edited Books. They actively participated in the workshop held for Developing Content Creation Skills using Moodles. The Moodles platform has been used by the faculty members to enhance the teaching experience and actively continuing the learning process for students in the tough times of Covid 19 pandemic situation. The Debate competition on the topic 'Aatm-Nirbhar Bharat will take India on a path of high economic growth' was organised by the department on 26 February 2021. This elicited a large participation, with multiple teams participating from various colleges in Delhi University and other universities, and from almost all courses of our college.

DEPARTMENT OF ELECTRONICS

Department of Electronics organized many academic and extra-curricular events during academic year 2020-21 despite the limitations imposed by lockdown. The Department Orientation Program was organized on 18 November 2020 before the start of the session for the 1st year students. The event is generally organized in month of July but was delayed this year as the admission process was delayed by the University. The event was attended by the first-year students, faculty members and the lab staff. The event was conducted through Google Meet platform. A lecture on 'Higher Education and Career Opportunities for Science Students in Taiwan' was delivered by Dr Sandeep Sharma, Post Doc Fellow, Chang Gung University, Taiwan on 26 November 2020. The lecture was delivered via Zoom platform and was attended by over 50 students across various courses in the college. The talk gave an insight to the students to know various opportunities available to them both in the field of higher education as well as the job market in Taiwan. Dr Sharma also discussed the procedure and formalities needed to be completed for joining these organizations. Dr. P.K Pandey was the Convener and Dr. Maneesha, Co-convener of the event. A 4-hour hands-on workshop on 'Effective Communication and Interview Skills' was organized on 20 February 2021 on Zoom platform for the students of Department of Electronics. Ms Sushma, Project Manager, ST Microelectronics was the resource person for the workshop. About 30 students participated in the interactive workshop. Students learned the essential components for an effective communication, how to improve communication skills, barriers in communication among other important aspects. The workshop also stressed on interview skills to help the students especially the final year students who would be required to appear for various interviews for jobs and for admission in higher education institutes in a few months. Dr. P. K Pandey was the Convener and Dr. Maneesha, Co-Convener of the workshop. TechTitans Society of Department of Electronics organized its annual cultural festival 'Electrozeal – 2021' on 5 & 6 April 2021. The event was planned, designed and executed by student volunteers under the guidance of Dr. P. K Pandey, Dr. Maneesha, Dr. Chhavi Bhatnagar and Dr. Sachin Kumar. Geeks For Geeks, MAC Memes, DU Vibes, DURM and DU Express sponsored the festival. There were seven events organized in the festival. Following is brief detail of each event. The Programming / Coding event 'Realcoderithm' held on 5 & 6 April 2021 was very well received and students from all over India participated in it. The first round was conducted through our quiz-maker website. This was a MCQ round with time bounded questions. Questions were of 3 languages that is python, C and C++. Top 50% students were shortlisted for the second round which was our final round. This round was held on Coding Ninjas platform. In this round, participants were given 2 hours to solve 3 problems with their unique style of coding in any of the 3 programming language. Event coordinators for the event were Harshita Kapoor, Md Imran Ali, Gobind Rai, Vishal Anand and Shilpi. The next event 'Tech Quiz' was held in two rounds. Both the rounds were conducted online. This tested knowledge, skills, and speed of the participants. Sooraj, Aniket Kumar Sah, Yadvendra Mishra, Sourabh and Rishav Dev were the event coordinators. A general quiz event 'Quizz-o-Mania' was a fun and entertainment event. The event invited a huge number of participants across colleges and universities. Pariksha Garg coordinated the event. An online theme-based sketch making competition 'Sketchtronics' was held on 5 April 2021 through Google meet platform. The theme for this year's event was 'Electronics in 2050'. The event witnessed an overwhelming response from the students and presented their imagination and futuristic ideas through sketches. Pranav Uniyal coordinated the event. The event 'Enigma' tested the intelligence of the participants and challenged their observational and logical thinking skills to solve a murder mystery. The event coordinator for this event was Manjeet Negi. There was an IDEA, to bring together a group of remarkable people, and to see if they could come up with solutions to the problems not all of us could. The event 'Idea Pitching' was the place to be. The event kicked off in the afternoon of 5 April 2021. The event received an overwhelming participation from and outside the college. The judges had a tough job after listening to the impressive plans and concepts of the participants to solve the problems given by the organizers. Priyam Kumar was the event organizer. The last event of the festival was 'What's Your Knack', a talent hunt event. The idea was to bring about an ever-before-seen contest that appreciated talent of all genres of every kind. Numerous students of several colleges blew our minds away with their impeccable performances. Though enthralled by each and every one of them, the best 16 was short-listed by the jury. The participants actively

submitted another video of their respective performances. This highlighted their immense passion towards their knacks. Ritika Ojha coordinated the event.

DEPARTMENT OF ENGLISH

The department of English traditionally has a busy calendar of extracurricular activities. Faculty Student Research Seminar Series

Faculty Student Research Seminar Series (FSRSS), led by Dr. Prem Kumari Srivastava and Dr. Anupama Jaidev aims to provide space for sharing research interests between members of the faculty as well as students. Dr. Guntasha Tulsi delivered an FSRSS lecture in June 2020, where she deliberated upon the significance of archival research in a presentation titled 'Language, Identity and Archives: Sikh Newspapers and Influence of Colonial Modernity'. DEPARTMENT OF JOURNALISM

With educational institutions facing challenges since March 2020, classes continue to remain in online mode. From schools to colleges, every department/institution is trying every ounce of efforts to make learning accessible and easy. Just like the rest of the departments in Maharaja Agrasen College, the department of Journalism has managed to make the online route just same as the offline one and that too with much greater efficacy and effectiveness. Since

its inception in 1997, the journalism department of MAC has strived for connecting collegians with the real world and to facilitate practical learning in online mode, several virtual workshops have been undertaken by many experts and the college's own alumni.

On 27 August 2020, a lecture on 'Health reporting during Covid-19' was conducted to make students aware of the covid-19 crisis across the country with keynote speaker Ms. Prachi Salve, an alumna of University of Sussex, UK, Mumbai university and St. Xaviers college and a former Research Assistant at the Institute of Development Studies (UK). On 12 September 2020, an interactive session on the 'Art of Audio Narrative' was organized with Mr. Miguel Molina, who is a senior trainer for BBC World Service and Communications Coach and Lecturer at United Nations and University of Geneva. To enhance technical skills of students, the department organized a workshop on Photoshop editing techniques under the guidance of a graphic expert, Ms. Archana Arora. Along with this, the department also



hosted a panel discussion on 'Advertising world: creativity and business' on 19 September 2020. The panelists included Purnan Kaul, who has worked with notable agencies like Horlics, PayTM, SiceJet, Airtel etc. Mohit Pasricha, currently working with Lowe Lintas India as an Associate Director, he has worked with leading agencies like McCann world group and Wieden and Kennedy Delhi. Ayushi Anand is lead director at Schbang digital solutions, Bangalore. She has done some brilliant projects in the field of documentaries, short films, animated shorts etc.

On 27 January 2021, the department hosted an expert lecture on 'The issues and challenges faced by cubs in network society era' with Guest speaker Ms. Ksenia Kondratieva, a senior Russian Journalist and editor, who has had a decade long experience in South Asia. On 20 February 2021, an expert lecture on 'Importance of research in news gathering process' was held with guest speaker Professor Govind Singh, Mr. Singh is a professor at Indian Institute of Mass Communication who has previously been a senior producer at Aajtak, Deputy Editor at Zee News, Executive Editor at HT Media Ltd. and Amar Ujala magazines. He has covered several events of historical importance such as 9/11 incident, Afghanistan war etc and unveiled the February edition of the department of journalism's publication MACVOICE. On 10 April 2021 a symposium on 'Functioning of new media newsroom' with keynote speaker Mr. Sanjay Kumar who has been associated with several online media organizations like the Times Internet, NDTV Convergence, HT Media Ltd. and India Today group. He also works as Guest Faculty at Times School of Journalism, Delhi School of Journalism, Apeejay School of Mass Communication etc. On 16 April 2021, an expert lecture on 'Contemporary news coverage and conflict of ideological interests' was held with guest speaker Mr. Harsh Vardhan Tripathi, a renowned journalist. From 19 April to 21 April 2021, the college had its annual journalism fest 'Yatharth', which began with 2 expert lectures, first on 'News production process in broadcast media' with guest speaker Shri. Rakesh Tiwari, a veteran in media industry and currently working as senior output editor for NDTV India. He has a vast experience of 20 years in the industry and has worked with coveted organizations like Network 18 among others. The next lecture was held on 'Functioning of output in broadcast media'

with guest speaker Mr. Tabish Hussain, News Anchor at NDTV India. On 20 April a lecture on 'Contemporary sports journalism' was held with guest speaker Ms. Karishma Singh, a senior sports correspondent with Times Now who has covered major events for Times network like World cup 2019 and Olympics. She has been a part of several renowned organizations like India Today. On the final day of 'Yatharth', two proud alumni of the college joined the event. Ms. Shivani Mittal, a renowned filmmaker and linguist who won international accolades like First Cut Film, Montage film festival, Global youth film festival etc. She has also written and directed acclaimed short films like Tremors, Hairy tale, Bandish etc. and Ms Shweta Kothari, a celebrated journalist, news presenter, reporter etc. She is currently heading the newsroom at The Logical Indian and has worked with coveted organizations like NDTV, News X, CNBC TV18 etc. Dr. Rupa Rani, Assistant Professor from Central University of Karnataka was also present at the event. The students of the department attended a UNESCO workshop on International Radio Day on 13 February 2021. Students have also done internships in several reputed organizations like The Economic Times, IndiaSpend, DU Beat, DU Express, India Today, Sahara Samay, India News, India TV, Tripoto etc. With all these workshops, lively events, Internships, the journalism department is trying its best to provide some exceptional talent to the media industry.

DEPARTMENT OF MATHEMATICS

The department of Mathematics in the academic year 2020-21 had organised the following events: A one week national faculty development program on, 'Business Decision Making Using R' in collaboration with the GAD-TLC, SGTB Khalsa University of Delhi was held in the month of October-November 2020. The program was well attended by more than 70 participants from 17 different states. A talk by Professor Shanta Laishram on the topic, 'The World of Prime Number' was organised on 24 December 2020. The talk was very well received by the students. The departmental student society organised the department festival in April 2021. Many online competitions were held for the students during this time. The finals of these competition were completed on 21 & 22 April 2021.

DEPARTMENT OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Due to the pandemic, the sports activities were highly affected, but the sports students were engaged in sports training as per the the government protocol in stadium and training centers. However, significant tournaments could not be organised during this period. Our students specially archery teams practised continuously in Yamuna sports complex archery training centre. The players were practising to achieve the milestone at National tournaments, unfortunately the tournaments were postponed due to the second wave of corona. The college was planning to organise an Inter College football and basketball tournament for men and inter College basketball tournament for women. The same was planned in the month of April 2021 but was postponed due to severe corona conditions in Delhi and will be organised in the recent possible time.

DEPARTMENT OF PHYSICAL SCIENCE

The B.Sc. Physical Science Course Committee for the academic session 2019-2020 started functioning under the Convenorship of Dr Nibedita Khuntia, Assistant Professor, Department of Biology. The teachers-in-charge for the academic session 2020-21 are Dr. Parthasarathy for Department of Physics, Dr. Vandana Soni for Department of Chemistry and Dr. Meena Mehta for Department of Computer Science under this committee. The committee worked sincerely during the whole session by conducting several programs and organizing various activities for the benefit of the students.

Orientation Program - In the beginning of the academic session in August 2020, the Committee organized a virtual Departmental Orientation program for the newly admitted students. Faculty members of all the departments within B.Sc. Physical Science introduced their respective subjects to the students and explained their importance and application in real life.

LECTURE SERIES

Department of Computer Science - A webinar on Artificial Intelligence was held on 11 May 2020 in the morning hours in association with KV Computer Home Pvt Ltd. The webinar was attended by 35 students of B.Sc. and B.A Programme. This was followed by a webinar on Digital Marketing on the same day in the afternoon in association with KV Computer Home Pvt Ltd. It was a good opportunity for students to interact with the industry experts and get some insight on the topics mentioned. A webinar on Android Application with collaboration CEPTA, (a unit of Educational Service, Noida) was held on 12 May 2020 from 2.00 PM onwards. Another webinar on Skills for Industrial Revolution-4.0 was held on 20 September 2020 by UPES. The students got a fair idea on the upcoming challenges in industry and skill revolution.

Department of Chemistry - Prof Prasenjit Sen, Professor and former Dean, School of Physical Sciences, JNU delivered a very interesting and informative talk on the topic 'Relocating Laboratory Research to the Market: An

Opportunity Among Failures' in a webinar on 8 February 2021. The Principal, Dr Sanjeev Tiwari addressed the virtual gathering and extended a warm welcome to Prof Sen who began his talk by emphasizing on the need to take laboratory level experiments to real life.

Co-Curricular Activities:

Department of Computer Science- UNLOCK-IT, an online Poster Making & PowerPoint Presentation Competition was organised on 13 May 2020 for our college students. Web Weavers, an online on spot website designing Competition was held on 26 September 2020 to help them to excel in education and the latest technology by learning and applying various programming skill in (code your site) and using word press.



An online quiz competition on Computer Basic and Programming Skills was organised on 24 October 2020. A quiz is a mind-sport, which promotes active learning and provides the motivational impetus, where the players try to answer questions accurately. This quiz served the purpose of a brief assessment to gauge the skills, abilities, and knowledge of students. UNLOCK-2.0, an online Poster Making & PowerPoint Presentation Competition was organised on 17 April 2021. Participating in these activities helped our students to be more positive and feeling connected in a competitive manner with other in this crucial time. This was followed by an online quiz competition on Information Security and Cyber Ethics on 19 April 2021 with the objective to spread awareness and enhance student participation in acquiring knowledge in the subjects of information security, cyber threats, and cyber-crime and cyber ethics.

DEPARTMENT OF CHEMISTRY

A story writing competition was held on 26 May 2020 on the topic 'Social Distancing Led to Introspection'. The purpose of organising this virtual event was to allow students to express their experiences in these unusual times and to know how they are trying to adapt to this new normal. It was a delight to read all the heart-warming and interesting stories, some of which were emotional and some with a hint of humour and some with a belief of getting back to normal. In the preliminary round, twenty two teams, from various courses, participated and the top seven teams were selected for the finale. There was a tie in the final round and the tie-breaker question finally decided the winner. Bhavya and Vanshika from BSc Physical Science 2nd year got the prize for 2nd runners up. A debate completion on the topic 'New Education Policy: Merits & Demerits' was organised on 27 April 2021. Eleven students enrolled for debate in which nine students presented their views on the topic. Dr. Omkar Singh, Mr. Ashutosh and Dr. Ranvijai Ram judged the event. Shubhda, Shankar Kumar Gupta, and Spoorti of BSc Physical Science were winners for the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd prize respectively.

DEPARTMENT OF PHYSICS

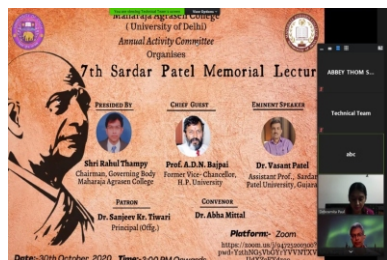
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COMMITTEE REPORTS

LIBRARY COMMITTEE



The Library of Maharaja Agrasen College was established in 1994 and has around more than 43734 books in its database along with 27 periodicals and magazines. The library stock verification was done on 9 November 2020 and is offering plagiarism check facility on URKUND software since 21 November 2020.

EBSB (Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat) Club

The Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat initiative, taken up by the Government of India, a programme which was set up to cherish and celebrate the rich cultural heritage of our country and to preserve and propagate its

INTERNAL COMPLAINTS COMMITTEE

Maharaja Agrasen College, University of Delhi has a ZERO tolerance policy against sexual harassment. The Maharaja Agrasen College Internal Complaints Committee was constituted in 2015 according to norms specified in the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013. The committee comprising of Dr Maneesha as Presiding Officer, Dr Shashi Singh, Dr Praveen Kant Pandey from teaching faculty, Mr Rajinder Bisht and Ms Surabhi from administrative staff and student representatives with Ms Manisha Aggarwal as external member followed due protocol in redressal of complaints and worked proactively towards increasing gender sensitization by organising lectures by Judicial officers and other experts to disseminate the finer nuances of the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013.

The ICC conducted a safety audit to make College Campus safe and secure for students. Feedback was sought from students based on their experience when they attended classes in the college campus in the year 2019-20. The feedback was analysed and a report based on the responses was submitted to the authorities.

A 10 days online Add on Course on 'Legal Awareness' was organized for students by Delhi State Legal Authority in association with Maharaja Agrasen College to spread Legal Literacy amongst the younger generation, to spread awareness about important Laws/Statute enacted in India and also to spread awareness about DLSA. The course was organized by the Internal Complaints Committee under the aegis of MAC-IQAC from 18 October 2020 to 10 November 2021. The course addressed important issues such as 'Equal Access to Justice' - Social Justice and Constitution of India, Understanding Indian Criminal Justice System, Overview of Cyber Laws, Equality in Practice - Laws in force for Protection of Women, Functioning of Police Administration & Virtual Tour of Police Station, Contractual Liabilities & Rent Laws: Jurisprudence and Applications, 'Rights of Children' & 'Wrongs by Children' – Important legal Provisions, Work with Dignity-Insights of The Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013, A Discussion on Purpose & Provisions of Right to Information Act, 'Equal Access to Justice' - Role and Duties of DLSA, Virtual Tour of DLSA/DLSA Virtual Tour of District Court. An online test was conducted at the end of the course. A total of 134 students benefitted from the add on course.

Internal Complaints Committee under the aegis of Internal Quality Assurance Cell and East District Legal Services

Authority organized an online awareness programme on the topic 'Sexual Harassment at Workplace' on 10 February 2021. Ms Sonal Chauhan, Legal Aid Counsel, from East District Legal Services Authority explained in detail about various laws pertaining to Sexual harassment at workplace to the audience which comprised of students, teaching faculty and non-teaching staff.

INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL (IQAC)

Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), Maharaja Agrasen College has been constantly working to develop a quality system to improve the academic and administrative performance of the College. The passing percentage for the session 2020-2021 in B.Com course is 95% and 89% in B.A course. Centre is committed to provide every possible platform to the students for their holistic development. In this view, Centre organized various events like quiz competitions, informative talks by experts and other Extra-Curricular activities throughout the year. These activities play an important role to enhance knowledge and intellect on students and also encourage them to showcase their hidden talents. Global Covid pandemic situation has changed the way of living. Teachers, students as well as Non-teaching staff have

NCC GIRL'S UNIT

National Cadet Corps is the youth wing of the Indian Armed Forces with its headquarters in New Delhi. Discipline and unity are the way of life and with this very motto our prestigious college has introduced NCC unit for the very first time in this academic session 2020-21. Our college believes in the empowerment of women and youth in general and that is the reason the college led by the Principal Dr. Sanjeev Kumar Tiwari brought forward this opportunity.
