

Guidelines for the Election of Maharaja Agrasen College Student Union (MACSU) 2024-25

The college student union election for the year 2024-25 is scheduled to be held on **27 September 2024**.

The election for Academic Year 2024-25 will held for the following posts of MACSU:

- (i) President**
- (ii) Vice-President**
- (iii) General Secretary**
- (iv) Secretary - Women Development**
- (v) Secretary - Social Welfare**
- (vi) Joint-Secretary**

Essential requirements to contest election

- (i) He/ She shall be a bonafide student of the college (Attach latest fees receipt with the form)
- (ii) **For second and third-year students:** He/ She should have a minimum 60% marks in aggregate in the preceding academic year. For second year students the calculation will be CGPA X 10 and for third year students the calculation will be CGPA X 9.5. There shall be no academic arrears/ERs. (Attach copy of marksheets of all previous semester examinations passed).
For first year students: He/ She should have a minimum 60% marks in class XII board examinations (Best of four subjects including one core language and three academic subjects). There shall be no academic arrears /ERs. (Attach copy of marksheet of class XII board examination passed).
- (iii) **For second- and third-year students:** He/ She should have a minimum percentage of 75% attendance in the preceding academic year.
For first year students: The attendance is waived off only for the academic session 2024-25.
- (iv) He/ She should be less than 22 years of age on 16th Aug, 2024.
- (v) He/ She should not be convicted of a criminal offence including moral turpitude.

- (vi) He/ She should not be found guilty by the College for any of the following acts of gross indiscipline:
- i. Physical assault, or threat to use physical force, against any person within the college;
 - ii. Violation of the status, dignity and honour of women, and students belonging to the scheduled castes and tribes
 - iii. Willful destruction of institutional property
 - iv. Causing disruption in any manner of the academic and administrative functioning of the college.
 - v. Elected office-bearer(s) of previous years are not entitled to hold any office twice.
 - vi. He/ She should adhere to the Lyngdoh committee guidelines, MAC Student Union Constitution and MAC code of conduct from the date of notification of this notice till the declaration of election results.
 - vii. Only students of 2nd and 3rd years of Maharaja Agrasen College are eligible to contest for the post of President and General Secretary.
 - viii. Final Year students are NOT eligible to contest for the post of Vice President and Joint Secretary.
